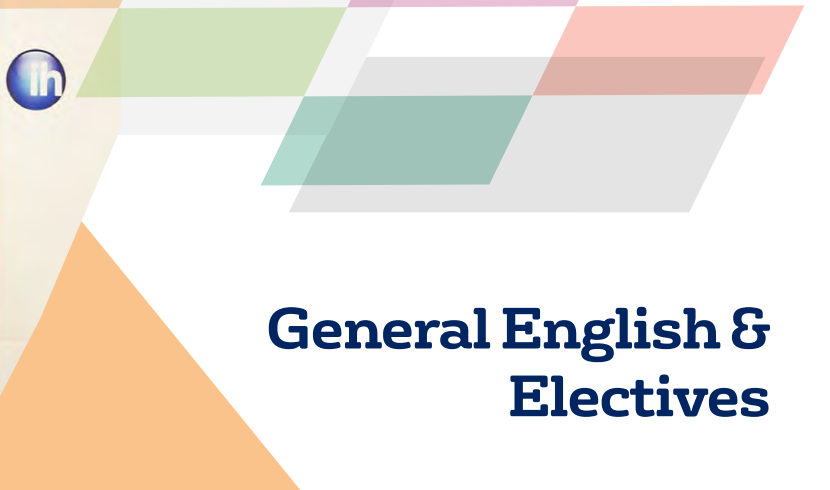

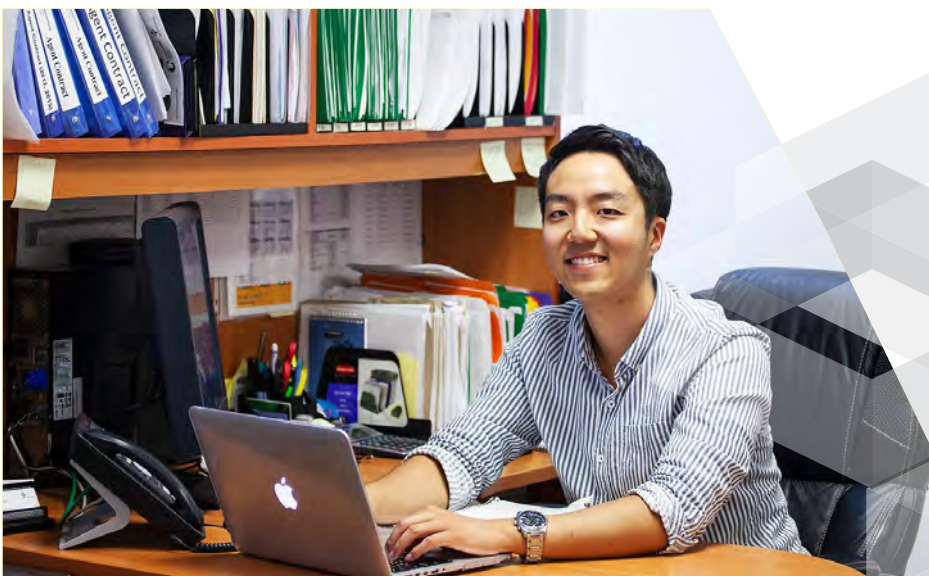

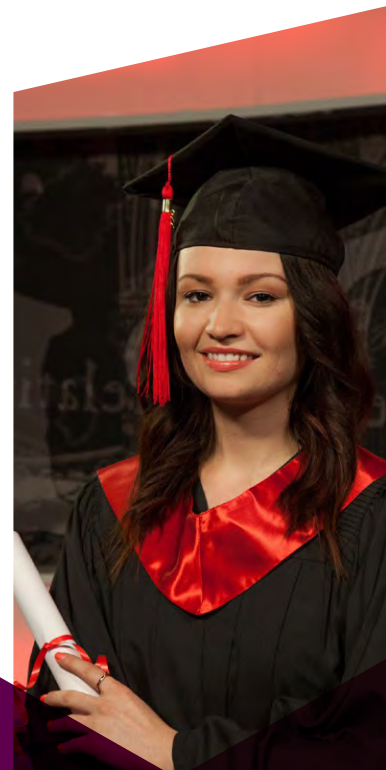

When you successfully complete the program, you will finish with the ability to **write, speak and listen at a level acceptable** for **academic** studies in Canada.

English for Academic Purposes consists of two levels

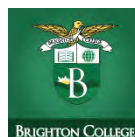

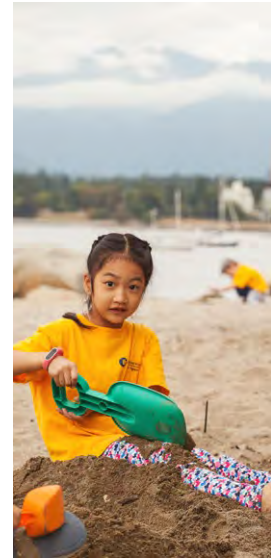
The Children's Adventure Program is a truly unique program **designed for children aged 5 to 12** of all English abilities. Your children can interact and make friends with other children from all over the world.

We want our students to feel at home during their stay in Vancouver and take particular care in choosing suitable accommodation options. We offer two types of accommodation:



Student House

IH Vancouver maintains two student houses.

Student house points:

- Available to students over 19 years of age.
- Offers independent living by sharing an entire house with other students.
- Both private and shared rooms are available.
- Kitchen, bathroom and laundry facilities are shared
- Meals are not included
- Bed linens are provided but students should bring their own towel.
- Internet, TV and telephone service all included



Homestay

Our homestays are carefully selected and located in safe and pleasant residential neighbourhoods. Homestay accommodation gives students the chance to participate in some of the family life, experience a different culture and most of all, practice their English skills at home.

It typically takes between 20 to 50 minutes to get to and from the school by public transit.

Homestay points:

- A private room with a bed, desk and storage space
- Full-board (breakfast, lunch and dinner)
- Shared bathroom (private bathroom available on request for an extra fee), laundry facilities, TV and free internet
- Linen, towels and toilet paper

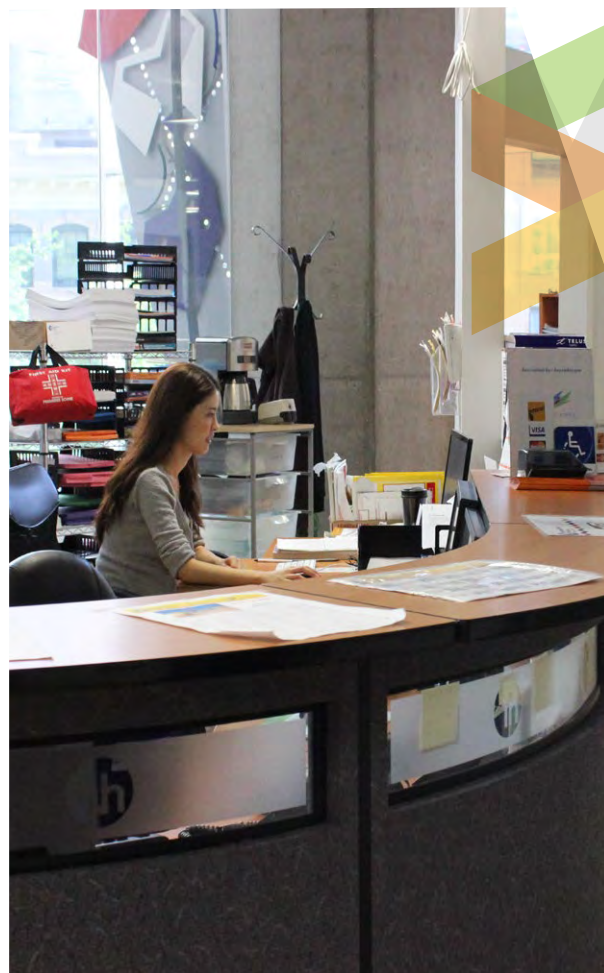
