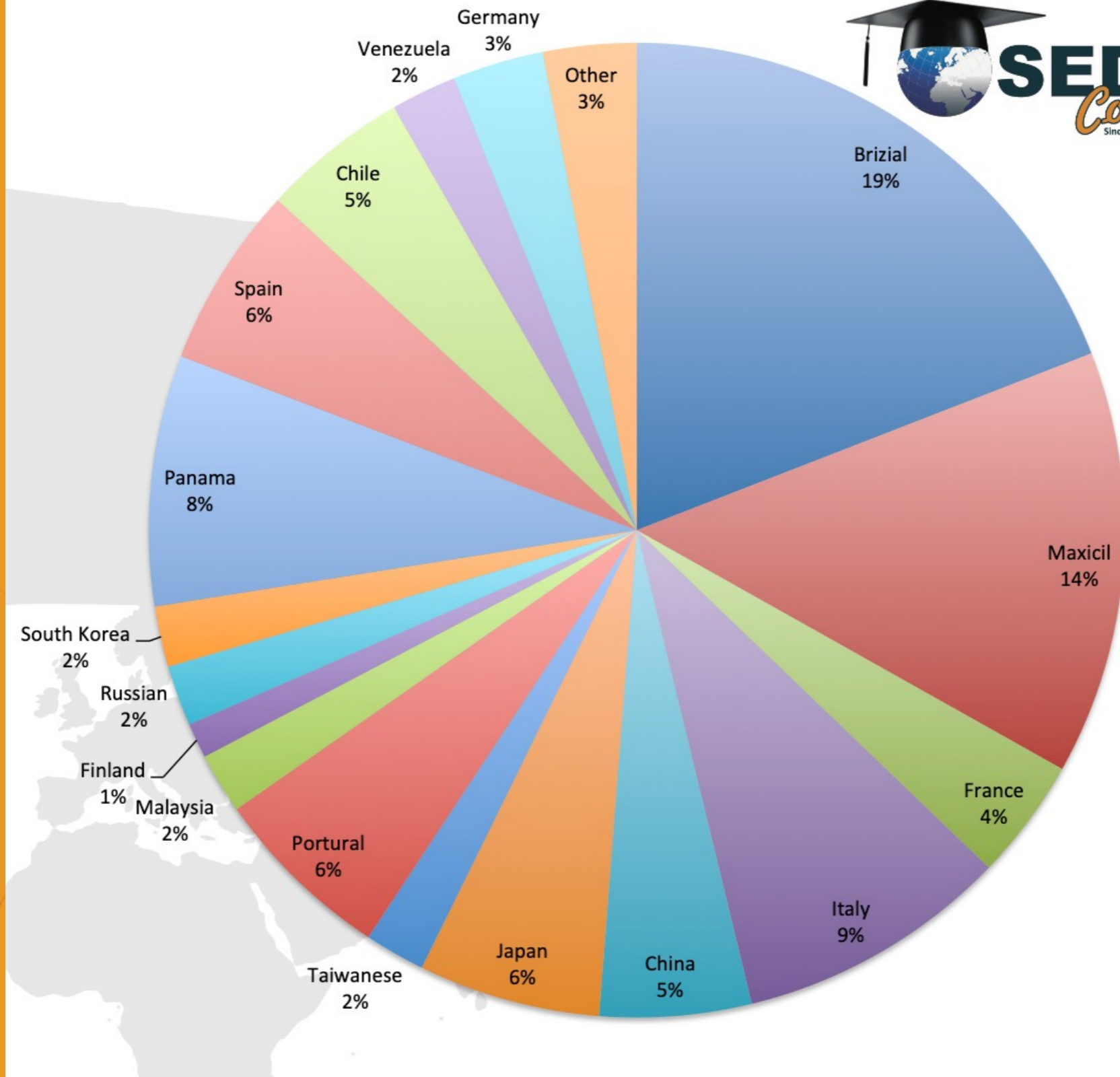

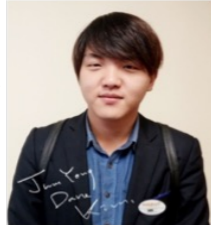


实习案例分享

Junyong Kim in SEDA College Here is his REAL internship story! Do you know how internship was?

1. Please introduce yourself.

– Hi, I am JunYong Kim from Korea. I'm working in the Maldron hotel, Parnell Square as "Dara" as part of an internship arranged by SEDA College. I've been living in Dublin since November 2013. I just finished my general English course in SEDA and thanks to SEDA, I got a chance to work in a hotel to get important experience for my future.



2. What do you do?

– I am working as a reservation assistant in my hotel. My main duty in our hotel is to check guests' reservations from a lot of online agencies like Booking.com or Expedia and putting them into our reservation system and making registration cards for customers. And additionally I call customers to confirm their reservations and their arrival time to help the receptionist to prepare to welcome our customers. Another important thing is to check all customers' booking details and make sure that there isn't any wrong information, otherwise customers are going to complain a lot and it makes our hotel's reputation really bad. Because we handle a lot of reservations per day, and we are not machines there are always some mistakes, when I find those mistakes, I usually feel really satisfied about being able to help.

3. Why did you start to do an internship?

– Before I came to Dublin, I was thinking to apply for the internship through SEDA College, and I heard SEDA has a system to arrange internships for students and that is one of the reasons that I decided to come to SEDA College.

I think I am still young and I have a long future ahead, so it is really important to be paid to, but also getting experience for the future is important.

The main reason, however, is my dream, since I was a high school student, I wanted to be a hotel manager. They always seemed impressive, the way they were welcoming their guests and really strict manner and polite speech style and neat dress. Because of that, I thought it would be a really nice experience to work in a hotel as an intern and as I expected, I'm learning many things about the hospitality industry through my hotel.

4. Could you tell us your impression of doing on?

– Actually I was extremely nervous before I started to work in the hotel, I don't remember really clearly, but as I thought, it was really difficult, because I haven't worked in the hospitality industry before so many words that I heard in the hotel were unfamiliar.

However, I thought it is possible to overcome and so I studied harder to become accustomed to it. It is really awkward to say myself, I am learning really easily even though it is a little confusing and quite unfamiliar, so because of that, I could learn easily, and also many of my co-workers in the office were encouraging me by saying that I've been learning well, this gave me the strength that I needed in order to endure the first moments as a stranger in the hospitality industry.

5. What is the most difficult thing during an internship?

– Of course, there was a language problem. Because I am not a native English speaker, making conversation was not difficult, but making jokes or having friendly relationships was a bit difficult. And as I mentioned in question 4, hospitality words were unfamiliar so that was the most difficult. But I am no longer having any difficulties.

6. What is the most memorable episode during on internship?

– Actually everybody in the hotel has been really friendly and encouraging, so almost nothing, but only once, I was scolded by my supervisor. I was calling customers and it was the weekend, so I was calling to confirm the guests' arrival time, but suddenly the supervisor scolded me about our work. I was really embarrassed because there was nothing wrong, but it was because of customer complaints. The day before, one of my co-workers had been calling and I was calling the same customers again at that moment, so they felt bothered and actually it was our fault that we didn't confirm our tasks. Since then, we made our own kind of rules for checking our work and there haven't been any problems.

7. Could you say something for some students who want to do an internship?

– Some students might think that they won't be able to work in hotels or companies with Irish people because of language difficulties, and other students might worry that they need to make money.

Actually, I believe we need to change our mind-set. It is much better to try to do something new even if it seems dangerous or difficult, it is certainly better than simply worrying and doing nothing, and you are still young, so you should try to learn what you want to do.

I will admit that it is quite difficult to work without getting paid, but we can gain experience instead of money and this experience is going to have much greater worth in the near future.

If you want to get really excellent experience for the future, go to the SEDA College website and apply for an internship right now. The internship manager, Viktor, is always kind so he will help you with it.

To take part in the SEDA College internship programme you need to

- Be over 18 years of age
- Be enrolled for at least 6 months course in SEDA College
- Have Intermediate or higher level of English
- Have private medical insurance (at least for the duration of your internship)
- Have some qualifications and experience in your chosen field of work

Chaesoon Lee in SEDA College Do you want to join internship program in Dublin? You'd better check this amazing story!

1. Please introduce yourself.

– Hello, I am Chaesoon Lee, and I am studying English. About ten months ago, I arrived in Ireland and in May I finished my general English course of 6 months. Now I am working in Belvedere hotel as an intern through SEDA's internship program.

2. What do you do?

– The main job is house keeping that clean rooms, in which customers stayed and left. I change the bed sheets, organize stuff used, clean the bathroom, change the air, and so on.

I manage the hotel environment as well. I keep the hotel lobby, public toilets and stairs clean. And I serve some stuff for services that the customer wants.

3. Why did you start to do an internship?

– I wanted to experience as many things as I can on abroad. Then one day I heard SEDA ran the internship program. So I thought it was a perfect opportunity to have a new experience so I applied.

I felt too bored after finishing my course. Although I was working as an au-pair, I had lots of free time. So I felt like I was wasting the time often I did not want to waste my time and I wanted to do something meaningful, fruitful.

4. Could you tell us your impression of doing on?

– I am very satisfied in my intern work. Even though I feel so tired, it is good work to learn many things. I can learn how the hotel is running and I can use English much more for conversation with other staff during work time. Furthermore I can feel spending time, productively. So I am very happy with this job.

5. What is the most difficult thing during an internship?

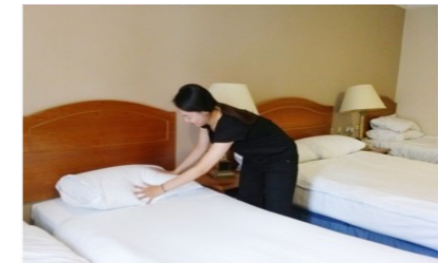
– It is a tough job, I need lots of energy. So in the first week I felt very tired physically. I just worked 4 hours, but I fell into bed as soon as, I arrived home. But I could get used to the work thanks to other staff who understood I was tired.

6. What is the most memorable episode during on internship?

– It is just 4 weeks, a short-term job, so there is not any more memorable cases. But I was surprised about some customers staying in the hotel for 3, 4 months or more. Especially, some families having children. Almost all the children were young, I was so sorry for them, they can not play enough in hotel room, living in an uncomfortable environment.

7. Could you say something for some students who want to do an internship?

– To be honest, you might regret the job. Because it is a no pay for on intern and a lot of hard work physically. On the other hand, it is a to make new friends, learn a new job and spend your time more fruitfully. Furthermore, if you are lucky you can become to an employee. So do not worry too much, just try!
