🌍 Student Nationality Breakdown...

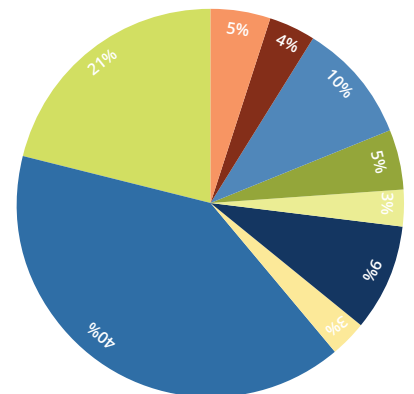

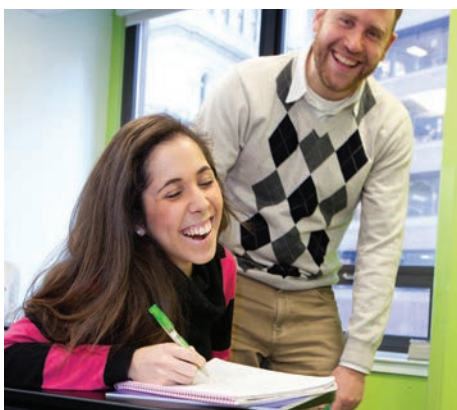

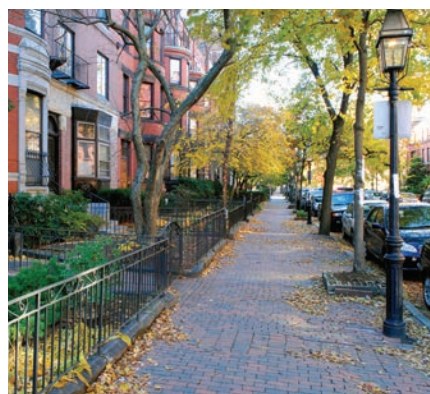

STUDENT VISA Students enrolling in a minimum 24-lesson per week course are eligible to receive an I-20 form in order to apply for a student visa in their country.



ACADEMIC TUTORING At all ELC centers, teachers provide students with additional academic help, free of charge, during designated hours.



WI-FI AND COMPUTER LAB Each school provides free wireless internet access and each school operates a computer lab for student use.



STUDENT ORIENTATION There is a full orientation for students on the first day of school. Students have an opportunity to meet staff members and receive an ELC orientation booklet and ELC map.
